Here are the instructions to access the news group.

Name of the newsgroup: ucb.class.ee143.

Use either Netscape Messenger of Outlook Express to subscribe to the newsgroup.

## Instructions for Outlook express:

- 1. Click on 'Tools' in the main menu.
- 2. Click on 'Accounts'
- 3. Click on 'News'
- 4. Click on 'Add' and then choose 'News'
- 5. Follow the procedure for entering your name and email information. Keep clicking 'Next' after each step.
- 6. When it asks for the news(NNTP) server, enter news.berkeley.edu (This is the newsgroup server)
- 7. Click 'Next' and click 'Finish' after that.
- 8. Once it gets the information about all the available newsgroups, select the groups you want i.e. ucb.class.ee143.
- 9. You are all set to receive the messages. There are some messages already posted.

## **Instructions for Netscape Messenger (Netscape 6):**

- 1. Click on 'Edit' in the main menu.
- 2. Click on 'New Accounts'
- 3. Choose 'Newsgroup account' and then click 'Next'
- 4. Enter the name and email address and click 'Next'
- 5. When it asks for the news(NNTP) server, enter news.berkeley.edu (This is the newsgroup server)
- 6. Enter the name with which you will refer to this account (choose any name)
- 7. Click finish to save and exit the setup.
- 8. Right click on the account name in the toolbar (In Netscape Messenger)
- 8. Once it gets the information about all the available newsgroups, select the groups you want i.e. ucb.class.ee143.
- 9. You are all set to receive the messages. There are some messages already posted.

## Access from non-UCB computers

The campus USENET newsgroup server is news.berkeley.edu. This server restricts access to UC Berkeley campus computers only, so it will deny access if you are using your own ISP.

Ways to work around this restriction:

1. Use our password-protected WEB site: http://inst.eecs.berkeley.edu/webnews; accesses news.berkeley.edu only. Requires an Instructional UNIX login/password <#accounts>. 2. Login to a UNIX system on campus: For example, you could "ssh" into "cory.eecs.berkeley.edu" and type "rn ucb.class.ee143" to read that newsgroup.
